## Road Scholar Program



The Road Scholar Program is designed to provide a core body of knowledge to county highway engineers, supervisors, county commissioners city engineers, street commissioners, and other highway and street personnel. Participants who complete all 12 core courses and obtain 300 activity and employment credits will earn the designation of Road Builder. Participants who earn 600 credits will earn the designation of Master Road Builder.

**The Stormwater Drainage Conference is considered an elective course in the program and is worth six (6) credits.**

## Continuing Education Units (CEU)/ Professional Development Hours (PDH)

Continuing Education Units (CEU) are a standardized, nationwide method of recognizing and rewarding participation in non-credit educational activities. Participants will receive 6 PDH/0.6 CEU.
